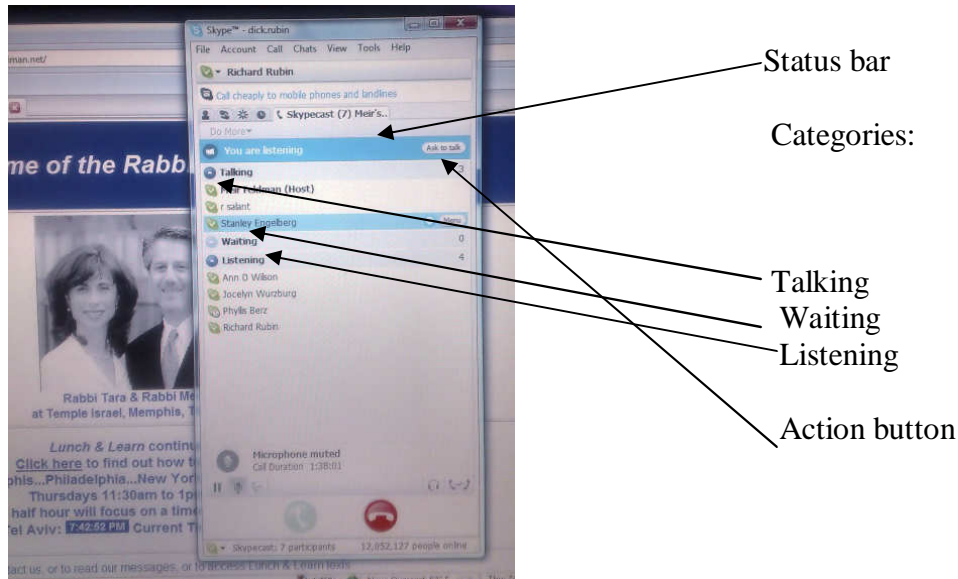


Skypecast Procedures

A view of the skypecast screen:



Skype Cast Screen Details

The picture above shows you what the Skypecast screen looks like after you get connected. It is from the viewpoint of a participant in the skypecast.

- 1) You see the status bar. It is currently indicating that the participant is listening.
- 2) Below the status bar are the category bars: Talking, Waiting, and Listening.
- 3) You also see the name of the skypecast host, Meir Feldman.

You can also see the names of various participants. Meir, rsalant, and Stanley Engelberg are listed under Talking. These people are the ones who currently can talk. The other participants are in the Listening category.

You also see an action button on the right of the status bar. This participant is currently listening. The action button says “Ask to talk”. If this participant wishes to speak, he/she must click this button. When the participant clicks this button, the participant is moved from Listening to Waiting.

Skypecast participants cannot put themselves in the Talking category. Only the Host can do this. When the host sees someone in the Waiting category, he/she has the power to allow them to speak. When he/she is ready to hear this person, she/he will click “Allow to speak” by that person’s name. That person will be moved from Waiting to Talking.

When a participant finishes speaking, he/she will see “Just listen” on the right of the status bar and can move back to Listening by clicking that button. If the participant doesn’t move himself/herself, the host has the power do it.

This, briefly, is what to expect when you join the skypecast.
